

WRARC NET CONTROL SAMPLE SCRIPT

QST, QST, QST. This is (Your name & call sign) Net Control Operator this evening, for the Western Reserve Amateur Radio Club Net. **The Club call sign is W8WRC.** This is an open net and all amateurs are welcome to check in.

This net meets each Friday evening at 9:00 P.M. on the KD8DWV repeater, 145.270 - PL 110.9. We thank Liz and Dave for allowing us to use their repeater. (PAUSE)

Is there any priority or emergency traffic please come now. (pause for three seconds) Please give your callsign, name and location. We will now take **low power and handheld checkins only**. (After they are done) We will now take all other checkins. Please leave a little time between checkins. Who will be the next check in? (After each check in) say something like “thanks for checking in (name)” then ask, “Next please”.

Try to keep a record of each check in. If anyone has information, note who it is and then continue on with checkins. (Use log sheet) (PAUSE)

After 10 to 15 checkins, allow any information to be given. It is now time for public service announcements or items of club business. (Call for the stations with announcements as noted from the net. Discuss any business.) Ask if there any questions for the person who gave the information. Are there any additional checkins, items of business, or announcements for the net? (Acknowledge any and make a note of them.) (PAUSE)

At this time does anyone have any swap and shop, Please come now. (PAUSE)

At this time are there any questions for the ELMER’S. (PAUSE)

Are there any comments or suggestions at this time? (PAUSE)

All amateurs are welcome to the Western Reserve Amateur Radio Club meeting held on the third (3rd) Tuesday evening, at 7:00 P.M., at the Davidson's Restaurant, 3636 Canfield Rd. Canfield Oh.
